

# Pink Flowering Ceanothus

Rhamnaceae

*Ceanothus x pallidus 'Marie Simon'*



## In the Garden

This semi-deciduous ceanothus will grow into a lovely moderately sized shrub of about 3'-6'.

Ceanothus Marie Simon unlike other varieties makes a lovely display of pink fluffy flower clusters that bloom mid to late summer & into the fall.

Responds well to a hard pruning while dormant.

**Sun:** Full Sun, Part Shade

**Water:** Dry, Light

**Soil:** Clay, Loam, Sand

**Other:** Attracts Butterflies, Attracts Bees, Attracts Birds, Deer Resistant, Drought Tolerant

**Ecological Value:**
